


Did You Know?

# Cellphones at High Rock


Did You Know?


**Do you have a smart phone?**




# Kids, Parents, and Technology




42% of High Rock parents monitor their child's internet usage.

# Kids, Parents, and Technology


41% of High Rock parents monitor their child's cell phone usage.

**Do you know anyone who has been harrassed online?**


