EVERSOURCE VEGETATION MANAGEMENT MEETING

The Board of Selectmen, along with Senator Michael Rush, Senator Richard Ross, and Representative Denise Garlick, will host a meeting of abutters who may be impacted by the vegetation management plan to be implemented by Eversource (formerly NStar) along the electric transmission Right of Way this fall.

Enclosed is the letter the Town received from Eversource that provides notification of the scheduled vegetation maintenance work and a map highlighting the route where the work will be performed. You are being notified, along with all abutters, because your address is located along this route. If work has been scheduled for your address, you should have already received notification directly from Eversource.

The Registry of Deeds has been working closely with Senator Mike Rush, Representative Garlick, and the Town to provide deeds for affected homeowners, so that they will have the most up to date information available as Eversource conducts its easement survey. Many of the deeds are available at Town Hall in the Town Manager's office. Residents may want to review these deeds in order to independently verify the results of the easement survey.
