**Presidential Primary – Tuesday, March 3, 2020**  
**Annual Town Election – Tuesday, April 14, 2020**  
**State Primary – Tuesday, September 1, 2020**  
**State Election – Tuesday, November 3, 2020**

The last day to register to vote and to change party enrollment for the Presidential Primary is Wednesday, February 12, 2020; for the Annual Town Election is Wednesday, March 25, 2020; for the State Primary is Wednesday, August 12, 2020; and for the State Election is Wednesday, October 14, 2020 from 9:00 AM – 8:00 PM. The Town Clerk's Office will be open for Voter Registration from 9:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M. Citizens may also register to vote online, at the Town Clerk's Office Monday through Friday from 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. and some second and fourth Tuesdays from 7:30 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.
