What: A Town-Wide Initiative to bring brightness & a smile during what will be a unique holiday season.

How to Participate: During the period of Thanksgiving weekend through New Year's weekend—help light up your neighborhood. It can be as simple as a candle in the window or as ornate and/or creative as you imagine. Theme is non-sectarian. To make it more interesting, we propose a different item be placed among your display so that passers-by can guess where it is:

Week of 11/30: *Hide a blue light*

Week of 12/7: *Hide a snowflake shaped item*

Week of 12/14: *Hide a bell*

Week of 12/21: *Hide a scarf*

Week of 12/28: *Hide a 2021 item*

Who can Participate: All Residents, Businesses, and Restaurants
