The Department of Public Works has completed its review of the above referenced Special Permit to allow the removal of the existing three car garage and build a new four car garage with additional exercise space. Relief is sought for the fourth bay structure within the setbacks.

The documents submitted for review are as follows:

- Application for Special Permit dated 10/7/22;
- Existing Condition Demo Plan and Proposed Plot Plan prepared by Claudio Sala both dated October 5th, 2022
- Owner Authorization Letter for Design Resource Team dated 10/6/22
- Architectural & Civil plans prepared by Design Resource Team and De Celle-Burke-Sala & Associates dated September 27th, 2022, consisting of 14-sheets.

Our comments and recommendations are as follows:

• In accordance with the Town of Needham Stormwater Bylaw, the proposed new structure requires a minimum combined volumetric capacity of 1 inch over the entire impervious area of the property to be recharged. The plans should be revised, prior to receiving a building permit, showing the calculations that the infiltration system is sized to contain a minimum of 1-inch of the total impervious area of the site for infiltration.

12 Clarke Road

Applicant is seeking a Special Permit under section **6.1.2** to add a fourth garage space for the construction of a new freestanding garage. The existing garage is pre-existing non-conforming because it was constructed within 10' of another accessory structure. To bring that building into compliance the shed and new garage will be attached, eliminating a new Zoning violation. The new structure will meet all the dimensional requirements for an accessory structure in the SRA District, I have no issue with the Special Permit.

69 High Street

The applicant is seeking a Special Permit to construct an ADU unit that will be accessory to the Single-Family Dwelling. The proposed construction of the ADU appears to meet all the requirements of the Zoning By-Law. MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION OF ERIC CARR 69 High Street, Needham, MA

The applicant, Eric Carr (hereinafter, interchangeably, the "Applicant" and "Carr"), has made application Special Permit pursuant to Section 1.4.6 of the Zoning By-Law, and a finding pursuant to M.G.L. c.40A, Section 6, for the change, extension, alteration and enlargement of a lawful, pre-existing, non-conforming structure, and a Special Permit pursuant to Section 3.2.1 of the Needham Zoning By-Law, to permit an Accessory Dwelling Unit, as well as any and all other relief necessary and appropriate to permit the proposed renovation and expansion of the existing single family dwelling at the Premises, as shown on the plans submitted with the application.

I. BACKGROUND

The Premises is shown as parcel 47 on sheet 64 of the Assessor's Map for the Town of Needham. It consists of approximately 10,204 square feet of land, with approximately 82 feet of frontage on High Street, on the northerly side, and 118.65 feet of frontage on Burnside Road, on the westerly side. The Premises is currently occupied by a two and one-half story, single-family residential dwelling. According to the records of the Assessor's Department, the house was originally constructed in either 1888 or 1907. It was subsequently altered and expanded, in 1983 and 1984, through the enclosure of the existing porch and the construction of an addition on the easterly side. And again, at an undetermined date, through an addition on the southerly side, which is located less than the required ten (10) feet from the southerly property line, and appears to have initially been used as a garage.

While the exact date of the addition on the southerly end of the house is not clear, the Assessor's photo from the adjacent property at 14 Burnside Road, taken in 1949, appears to show a garage with the same shape, size and location as the current southerly end of the house.⁴ Moreover, Assessor's photos for the Premises, dated September, 1985, also show the addition, in the same shape, size and location as at current, but with the garage door removed and windows installed in its place.⁵ Such is the condition which existed when the Carrs acquired the Premises in 2011, and which exists today.⁶

II. PROPOSED ALTERATIONS & RELIEF REQUIRED

The Carrs have lived at the Premises since they acquired it in 2011. However, in order to better accommodate their family, including their aging parents, they now desire to renovate and expand the house. In particular, they propose to modify the southerly end of the house, through a combination of additions and renovations. The end result of the modifications will be to add a second story addition that conforms with setback requirements; add a second story above the existing one-story, former garage addition on the southerly end that is nonconforming with setback requirements; add a one-story addition off the easterly side in the vicinity of the existing deck; and rearrange and renovate portions of the interior space. As a part of the alterations and expansion, the Carrs intend to make a portion of the southerly end of the house (on both the first and second floors) into an Accessory Dwelling Unit ("ADU"). While the one-story addition on the easterly side of the house, the two-story addition that complies with setback requirements and certain of the interior renovations do not require zoning relief, the addition of a new second story on the southerly end of the house, and the creation of the ADU both require special permits.

The proposed ADU is intended to provide a so-called "in-law suite" for Carr's parents, currently age 76. It is located at the southerly end of the house and consists of 849 square feet of total area on two floors. It contains a kitchenette and full bath, as well as two open areas; one for

living and one for sleeping. The ADU is accessed from the Principal Dwelling Unit by means of a door off a hallway near the westerly entrance to the house, as well as a door off a hallway on the second floor. There is also an additional ingress / egress to the outside via a door off the southerly wall of the ADU. While the ADU will be occupied by Carr's parents, the main portion of the house, as the Principal Dwelling Unit, will be occupied by the Carrs and their five children.

III. LAW

Section 1.1 of the By-Law states that is the intent and purpose of the By-Law to

promote the health, safety, convenience, morals or welfare of the inhabitants of Needham; to lessen congestion in the streets; to conserve health; to secure safety from fire, panic and other dangers; to provide adequate light and air; to prevent overcrowding of land; to avoid undue concentration of population; to facilitate the adequate provision of transportation, water, sewerage, schools, parks, and other public requirements; to conserve the value of land and buildings; to encourage the most appropriate use of land throughout the Town and to preserve and increase amenities under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 40A.

Pursuant to Sections 1.3 and 3.15.2(a) of the Zoning By-Law, an Accessory Dwelling Unit is defined as

An apartment in a single-family detached dwelling that is a second, self-contained dwelling unit and a complete, separate housekeeping unit containing provisions for living, sleeping, cooking and eating. This unit shall be subordinate in size to the principal dwelling unit on a lot and shall be constructed to maintain the appearance and essential character of the single-family dwelling.

Section 1.4.6 of the Zoning By-Law provides that

a lawful pre-existing non-conforming use may be changed or extended, and a non-conforming building may be structurally altered, enlarged, or reconstructed only pursuant to a special permit issued by the Board of Appeals pursuant to Section 7.5.2. No such permit shall be issued except in accordance with the requirements of Section 7.5.2 nor unless the Board shall determine that such change, extension, alteration, enlargement, or reconstruction would not be substantially more detrimental to the neighborhood than using the existing non-conforming use or structure. The issuance of a special permit hereunder shall not authorize the violation of any dimensional, parking or intensity regulation with which the structure or use was theretofore in conformity.

Pursuant to Section 3.2.1 of the By-Law, ADUs are permitted by Special Permit in the Single Residence B Zoning District. Section 3.15.2 sets forth the requirements for issuance of such special permit, which include the following, in pertinent part:

- (a) There shall be no more than one ADU on a lot, which ADU shall be located in the single-family detached dwelling and not in an accessory building.
- (b) At least one of the units, the principal unit or the ADU, shall be Owner-occupied, except for a temporary absence of the Owner for a period of nine months or less if written notice thereof is made to the Building Commissioner on a form prescribed by the Commissioner within 60 days of the commencement of the absence.
- (c) Occupancy of the unit that is not Owner-occupied shall be limited to a member of the Owner's Family or a Caregiver and such Caregiver's Family; provided that occupancy of the principal dwelling unit and the ADU combined shall be limited to five persons who are not Family of the Owner.
- (d) The size of the ADU shall be limited to 850 square feet of living space and shall have no more than one bedroom.
- (e) Off-street parking shall be provided for residents of both units with a minimum of one parking space per dwelling unit.
- (f) Adequate provisions for the proper disposal of sewage, waste, and drainage generated by the ADU shall be in accordance with Board of Health requirements.
- (g) Compliance with the ingress and egress provisions of the Massachusetts State Building Code, applicable to dwelling units, shall be required. To the extent possible, exterior entrances and access ways shall not detract from the single-family appearance of the dwelling. Where there are two or more existing entrances on the front façade of a dwelling and modifications are made to any entrance, the result shall be that one appears to be the principal entrance and the other appears to be secondary. An interior doorway shall be provided between each living unit as a means of access for purposes of emergency response. All stairways to additional floors shall be enclosed within the exterior walls of the structure.

And M.G.L. c.40A, Section 6, provides, in pertinent part, that:

Except as hereinafter provided, a zoning ordinance or by-law shall not apply to structures or uses lawfully in existence or lawfully begun, or to a building or special permit issued before the first publication of notice of the public hearing on such ordinance or by-law required by section five, but shall apply to any change or substantial extension of such use, to a building or special permit issued after the first notice of said public hearing, to any reconstruction, extension or structural change of such structure and to any alteration of a structure begun after the first notice of said public hearing to provide for its use for a substantially different purpose or for the same purpose in a substantially different manner or to a substantially greater extent except where alteration, reconstruction, extension or structural change to a single or two-family residential structure does not increase the nonconforming nature of said structure. Pre-existing nonconforming structures or uses may be extended or altered, provided, that no such extension or alteration shall be permitted unless there is a finding by the permit granting authority or by the special permit granting authority designated by ordinance or by-law that such change, extension or alteration shall not be substantially more detrimental than the existing nonconforming use to the neighborhood. (emphasis added)

Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40A, Section 7 provides, in pertinent part, that:

If real property has been improved by the erection or alteration of 1 or more structures and the structures or alterations have been in existence for a period of at least 10 years and no notice of an action, suit or proceeding as to an alleged violation of this chapter or of an ordinance or by-law adopted under this chapter has been recorded in the registry of deeds for the county or district in which the real estate is located ... then the structures shall be deemed, for zoning purposes, to be legally non-conforming structures subject to section 6 and any local ordinance or by-law relating to non-conforming structures.

IV. ANALYSIS / ARGUMENT

A. Southerly End Addition - Addition of New Second Floor

The existing southerly end of the house, which is currently only one story high, is set back 5.2' from the southerly property line. While it is unclear exactly when or how this portion of the house came to be, based on the Assessor's photos, and the fact that it was in existence when the Carrs acquired the property in 2011, it has clearly been in existence for more than 10 years. Moreover, a due and diligent search of the records of the Norfolk County Registry of Deeds from 1933 through the present, has failed to locate or reveal any notice of an action, suit or proceeding as to an alleged violation. Similarly, there is no such notice in the Building Department file, notwithstanding the existence of a letter from 1984 implying, but not specifying, an alleged zoning violation. As a result, pursuant to M.G.L. c40A, Section 7, as revised, the southerly end of the house which encroaches into the applicable setback is now deemed, for zoning purposes, to be legally non-conforming, subject to both M.G.L. c.40A, Section 6 and Section 1.4.6 of the Needham Zoning By-Law.

The Applicants propose to remove the southerly end of the house and rebuild it with an additional second story; no closer to the southerly property line than the existing structure. The overall effect will be to add a second story above the current non-conforming first floor. Whereas the current structure is pre-existing, non-conforming, a special permit pursuant to Section 1.4.6 of the Zoning By-Law and a finding pursuant to M.G.L. c40A, Section 6 are required for the proposed work. Pursuant to both the By-Law and the Statute, in order for such a special permit to issue, the Board must determine that the proposed reconstructed portion of the hosue, with the addition of a second floor, would not be *substantially* more detrimental to the neighborhood than the existing one story portion of the house.

Carr assert that the proposed work will not be more detrimental in any material way, and especially not in any substantial way. The reconstruction of the first floor space with the addition of new second story living space is not anticipated to have any materially different impact than the existing one story space. Moreover, whereas the proposed second story space and the reconstructed first floor will be no closer to the property line than the existing structure, there is no new or additional violation of any dimensional requirement.

B. Accessory Dwelling Unit

Carr assert that the proposed ADU meets all applicable requirements. There is only one proposed ADU and it consists of a self-contained dwelling unit that constitutes a separate housekeeping unit. The ADU contains provisions for living, sleeping, cooking and eating. The proposed ADU is subordinate in size to the principal dwelling unit and is designed such that it will maintain the appearance and essential character of the single-family dwelling. The Principal Unit will be occupied by the Carrs, owners of the Premises, and their five children. The ADU will be occupied by Carr's parents. The proposed ADU contains 849 square feet of area, in compliance with the applicable maximum size, and there is ample parking for both the Principal unit and the ADU. In as much as the proposed ADU is part and parcel of the house, no special provisions are required or contemplated relative to disposal of sewage, waste, and drainage. There is only one exterior entrance to the ADU, which is located on the southerly side of the house, and therefore, will not detract from the single-family appearance of the dwelling. The main entrance to the ADU is via an interior doorway between the Principal Unit and the ADU. Therefore, on the basis of the foregoing, Carr asserts that the issuance of a Special Permit authorizing the proposed ADU is both proper and appropriate and should be granted.

V. Conclusion

Carr is seeking to make changes to his house to accommodate his family. The first of those changes is an expansion of the first floor living area, on the easterly side of the house. The second of those changes is the construction of a small two-story addition on the westerly side. And, the third, and only change that requires zoning relief, is the reconstruction of the southerly end of the house with new second floor living space.

Carr asserts that the proposed changes are all in keeping with the existing house and the change requiring zoning relief will not be any more detrimental, let along substantially more detrimental, than the existing house. Therefore, Carr assert that the issuance of the necessary zoning relief is proper and appropriate, and requests that same be granted.

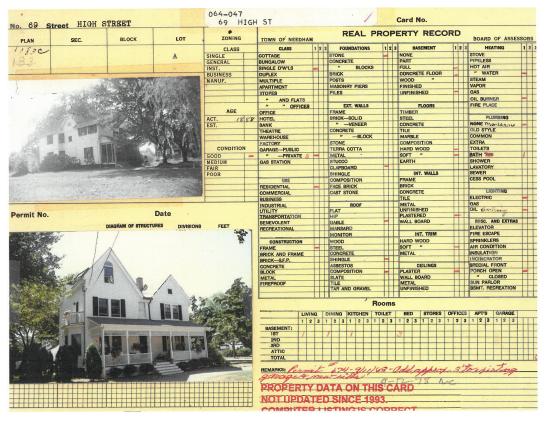

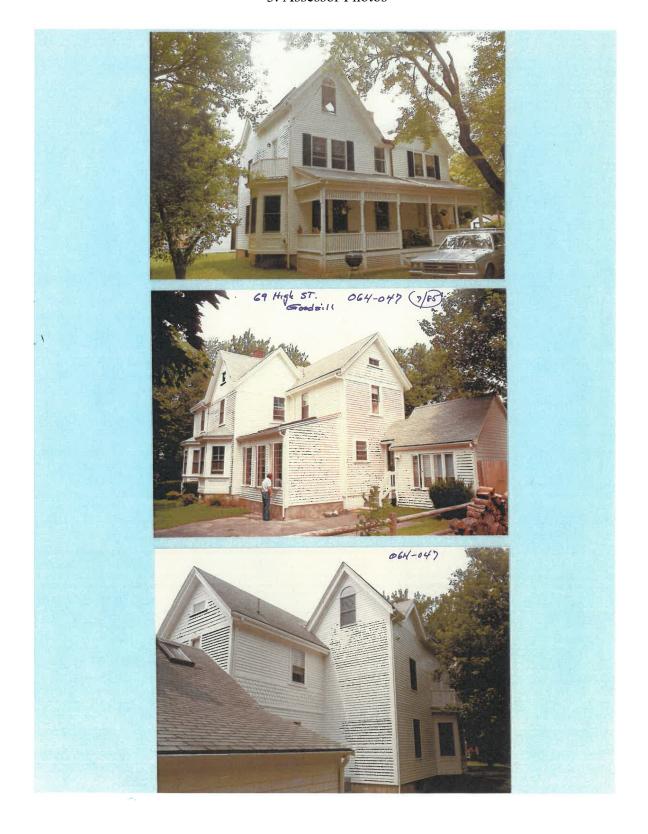

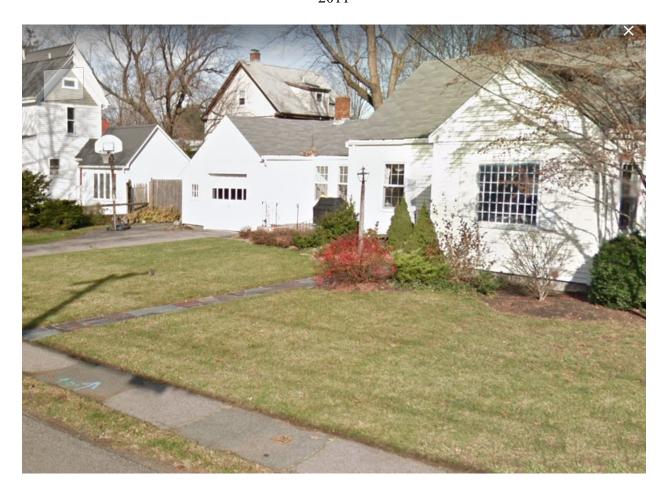

Dear Members of the Board,

The Department of Public Works has completed its review of the above referenced Special Permit to allow the proposed 2 story addition to the existing single-family home for an AHU.

The documents submitted for review are as follows:

- Application for Special Permit dated 10/22/22;
- Existing Condition Plot Plan and Proposed Plot Plan prepared by Cheney Engineering dated October, 6th 2022 and October 20th, 2022
- Town of Needham Plot Plan Dated May 2nd 1984
- Architectural plans prepared by CME Architects Inc. dated October 17th 2022 consisting of 4-sheets.
- Town of Needham Property Record Card with Photos

Our comments and recommendations are as follows:

• In accordance with the Town of Needham Stormwater Bylaw, the proposed new structure requires a minimum combined volumetric capacity of 1 inch over the entire impervious area of the addition to be recharged. The plans should be revised, prior to receiving a building permit, showing the calculations that the infiltration system is sized to contain a minimum of 1-inch of the total impervious area of the addition for infiltration.

I have reviewed the applications for the November 2022 hearing and have the following comments.

12 Clarke Road

Applicant is seeking a Special Permit under section **6.1.2** to add a fourth garage space for the construction of a new freestanding garage. The existing garage is pre-existing non-conforming because it was constructed within 10' of another accessory structure. To bring that building into compliance the shed and new garage will be attached, eliminating a new Zoning violation. The new structure will meet all the dimensional requirements for an accessory structure in the SRA District, I have no issue with the Special Permit.

69 High Street

The applicant is seeking a Special Permit to construct an ADU unit that will be accessory to the Single-Family Dwelling. The proposed construction of the ADU appears to meet all the requirements of the Zoning By-Law. The applicant is also seeking a Special Permit under section **1.4.6.** alter or extend a lawful pre-existing non-conforming structure, one of the additions is 9.4' from the lot line where 10' is required to issue the permit by-right. The existing structure in this location is 5.2' from the lot line, therefore the second story addition proposed will also be 5.2' from the lot-line when constructed. All other setbacks will be compliant for a Structure constructed before 1986.
