

TOWN OF NEEDHAM TRUSTEES OF MEMORIAL PARK

MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, August 15, 2018 – 7:00 PM – Public Services Administration Building

PRESENT: John Gallelo, Chair; Chuck Mangine; Dan Matthews, BOS

GUESTS: Matt Borrelli – BOS; Representatives of Parent Talk - Alison Levy and Caitlin Furcillo

The meeting was called to order by Chair John Gallelo at 7:05 pm.

Alison Levy and Caitlin Furcillo, representatives of the Needham-based non-profit Parent Talk, presented a request that they be allowed to have a Kona flavored ice truck at the group's Flicks on the Field family movie event on the evening of August 25.

It was noted that the Trustees have generally not allowed food trucks at the park. However, there is no concession stand at this time, and this is a limited event.

Dan Matthews moved that the Trustees authorize Parent Talk to have a flavored ice truck at its August 25 Flicks on the Field event, subject to receiving the necessary permits through the Town Manager's Office.

It was noted that this is for a one-time approval and not a precedent. Chairman Gallelo cautioned the representatives of the importance that children not play on the monuments, which the representatives acknowledged and stated they would see to.

The motion was approved by Unanimous Vote.

The agenda included a planned meeting with the athletic director and new football coach, but there may have been a miscommunication, and they did not attend.

The next meeting of the Trustees is scheduled for Wednesday, September 19, 7 PM, at PSAB.

At approximately 7:30, a motion was made, seconded, and Voted, Unanimously, to adjourn.
