## ROSEMARY SEDIMENT REMOVAL PROJECT

The final permit – the Water Quality Certification – finally was sent to DPW Engineering this morning. The consultants are reviewing the certificate's impact on the project and will be contacting DEP for clarifications. A discussion on timing will need to be held, as the original schedule of an early fall start/late spring completion cannot be met. I've already shared the Commission's prior statements that the lake not be impacted by the project during the pool season.

#### ROSEMARY PARKING LOT

One of the maintenance needs for porous pavement is regular vacuum/sweeping. The lower lot and driveway will have its first post-construction vacuum on Monday, October 8<sup>th</sup>. The lines were recently repainted after a section was re-installed.
