- **Article 30 CPA/Town Common**

Suggested Motion: That the Board vote to support article 30 as amended by deleting the words “FY2019 CPA General Reserve” and inserting in place thereof the words “Open Space Reserve.”

- **Article 51 Nuclear Non-proliferation**

Suggested Motion: That the Board make the following statement under Article 51: “The Select Board recommends that the focus of the Town Meeting Warrant be on matters within the scope and responsibilities of Town government, and not on matters where primary responsibility is vested in other levels or agencies of government, and in which our residents have a direct opportunity to be heard, except in extraordinary circumstances. Additionally, the Board does not have expertise, or ready access to full information, to conclusively advocate a position for or against the petition. That having been said, Article 51 has been submitted by citizens' petition, and is lawfully before Town Meeting for consideration. The Select Board does not take a position, for or against, with regard to the specific provisions of Article 51.”
