- Member Welcome and Introductions (Kristen Mazzocchi, Chair)
 Roll call of council members present. Notice of zoom open meeting including code of conduct. Quorum met.
- Approval of Past Minutes (Kristen Mazzocchi, Chair)

 Motion to approve past minutes 1st by Sharon Breitbart, 2nd Anne McCaffrey. Motion passed unanimously.
- Update on MCC Grant Process (Kristen Mazzocchi, Chair)
 Review of MCC grant modifications. Last meeting blanket vote to approve modifications. Discovery Museum modification received and approved since then. Meet Julia Childs and Dance Caliente still to be granted awaiting further communication. Action Item: Post modification letters on drive.
- -Update on End of Year Reception Newsletter (Kristen Mazzocchi, Chair)
 Julia Gould reports on the newsletter. Photos to be included. Section about art box and other council happenings to be included? Include Survey. Motion for Marking committee to have carte blanche to create newsletter. Committee meeting to happen over summer. 1st by Kristen Mazzocchi, 2nd Gail Lustig. Motion passed unanimously. Committee consists of Sharon Breitbart, Julia Gould, Monique Harrington, Kristen Mazzocchi, Charly Nanda.
- Update on Media Plan (Yael Halpern, Member).

Yael Halpern reported that the new Art box article was submitted to Needham Times and Hometown Weekly. We have permission to use a calendar that can be uploaded to Town website. Needs to be approved by Town technology committee. Further need to research into appropriate calendar platforms. The survey will include a question to assess the needs of the community for publicity of events with a calendar. Also for possible inclusion in newsletter update of what artists have been creating virtually during the pandemic. For example, the Arlekin Players Theatre and Needham Community Theater performing shows via zoom. Confirmation was received from the town that committees can do work that is within its parameters as directed by the Council as long as the group is smaller than a quorum.

- Update on potential public art projects (Kristen Mazzocchi, Chair)
 - Art box- Next step is to be included in Select Board Consent Agenda. The third art box project needs to be developed and has secured funding from

- Middlesex bank at \$1500.
- Murals- Potential to partner with Community Center who wants to do an indoor mural with Middle School principal, Tamatha Bibbo. That would not need Select Board approval. Reach out to Paul Good at NCRTF to see what murals are in process to partner on. Town interested in sidewalk murals especially safety reminders such as "heads up, phones down."
- Picnic table potential for town center discussed. Ultimately, discussion concluded that because of difficulty with funding and purchasing it would not be able to be executed in time for maximum outdoor use. Action Item: Acquire towns list of pre-approved vendors.

Other ideas included getting connected to Complete Streets initiative of the town and using plexiglass art as an industrial design art project barrier.
